Three elegant Suzhou women musicians costumed in Whispering Lotus Chi-pao give us a concert on Chinese Lovers' Day.

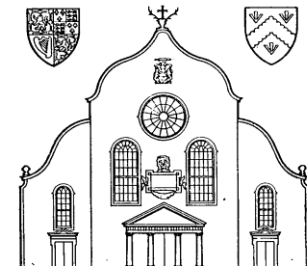
